

Is It Bullying?

Senate Bill 179, “David’s Law”, expanded authority to school districts to address bullying off-campus and outside school-related or school-sponsored activities based on specific criteria. This flowchart helps parents and the community understand if a student has been bullied according to the legal definition.

If any identified section does not receive at least one checkmark, then the act is not considered bullying by state law but may violate the Student Code of Conduct.
