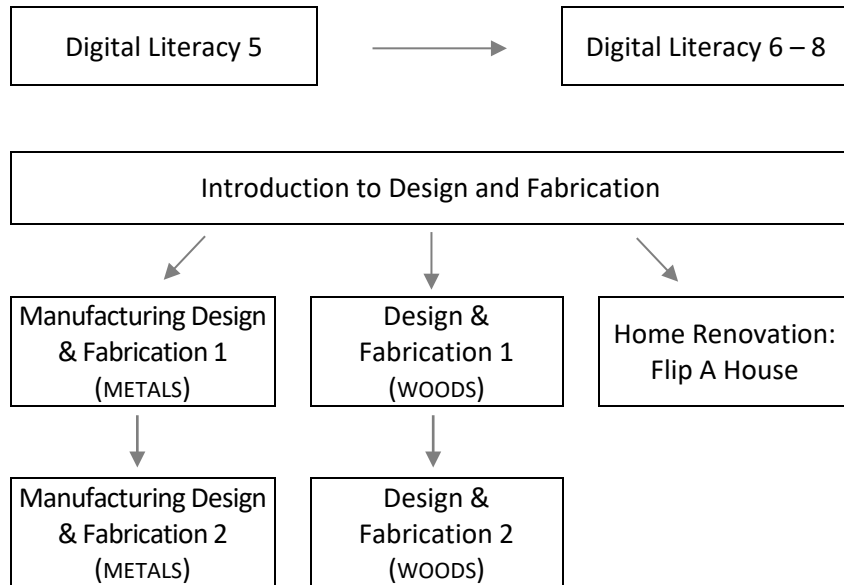

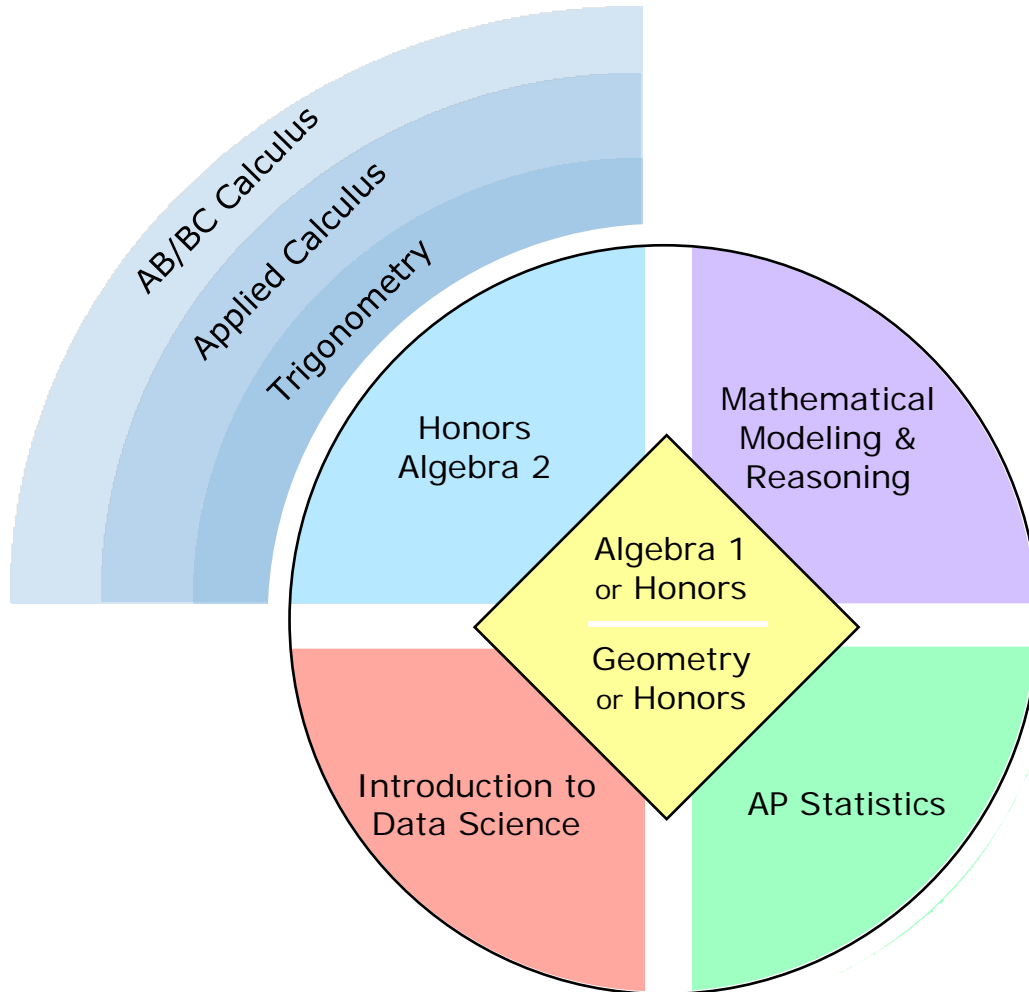
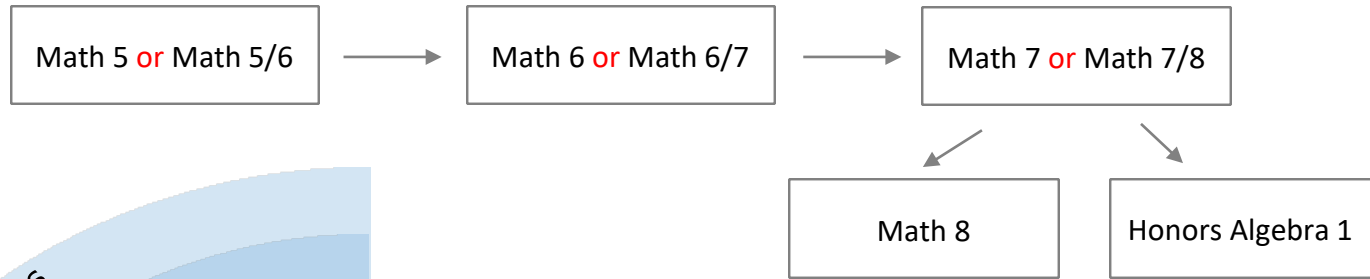
Graduation Requirement: All students must earn 1 fine art credit in grades 9-12, or a fine art waiver may be granted if the student completes 2 semesters any time in grades 7-8. Students taking a career-technical pathway are exempted from the fine arts requirement.

MATHEMATICS COURSE MAP

 Must take both courses. They are a state Math graduation requirement and include a state end-of-course (EOC) exam. Four math credits are required for graduation (this must include Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 or equivalent).

 These four courses are considered an Algebra 2 equivalent.

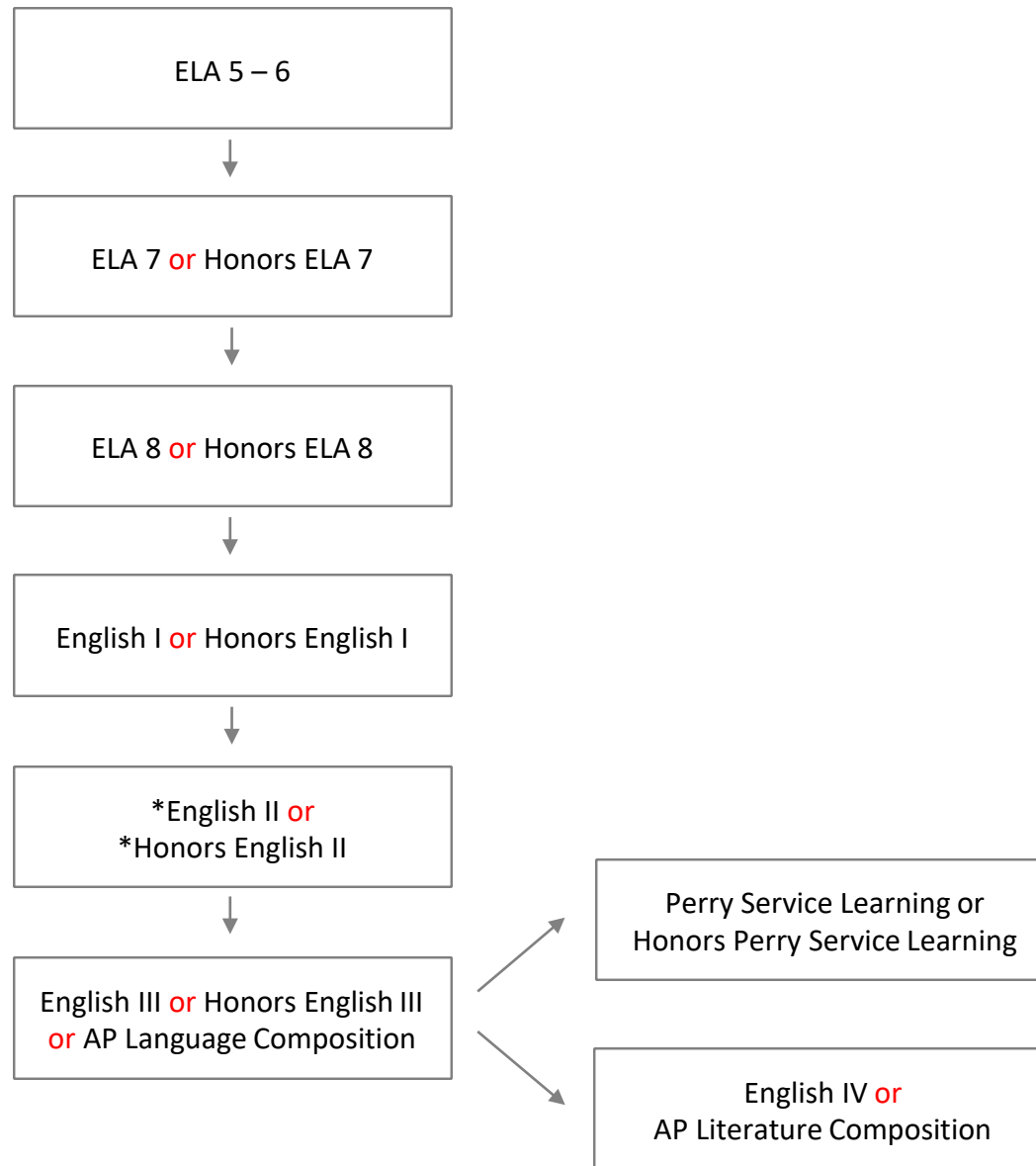

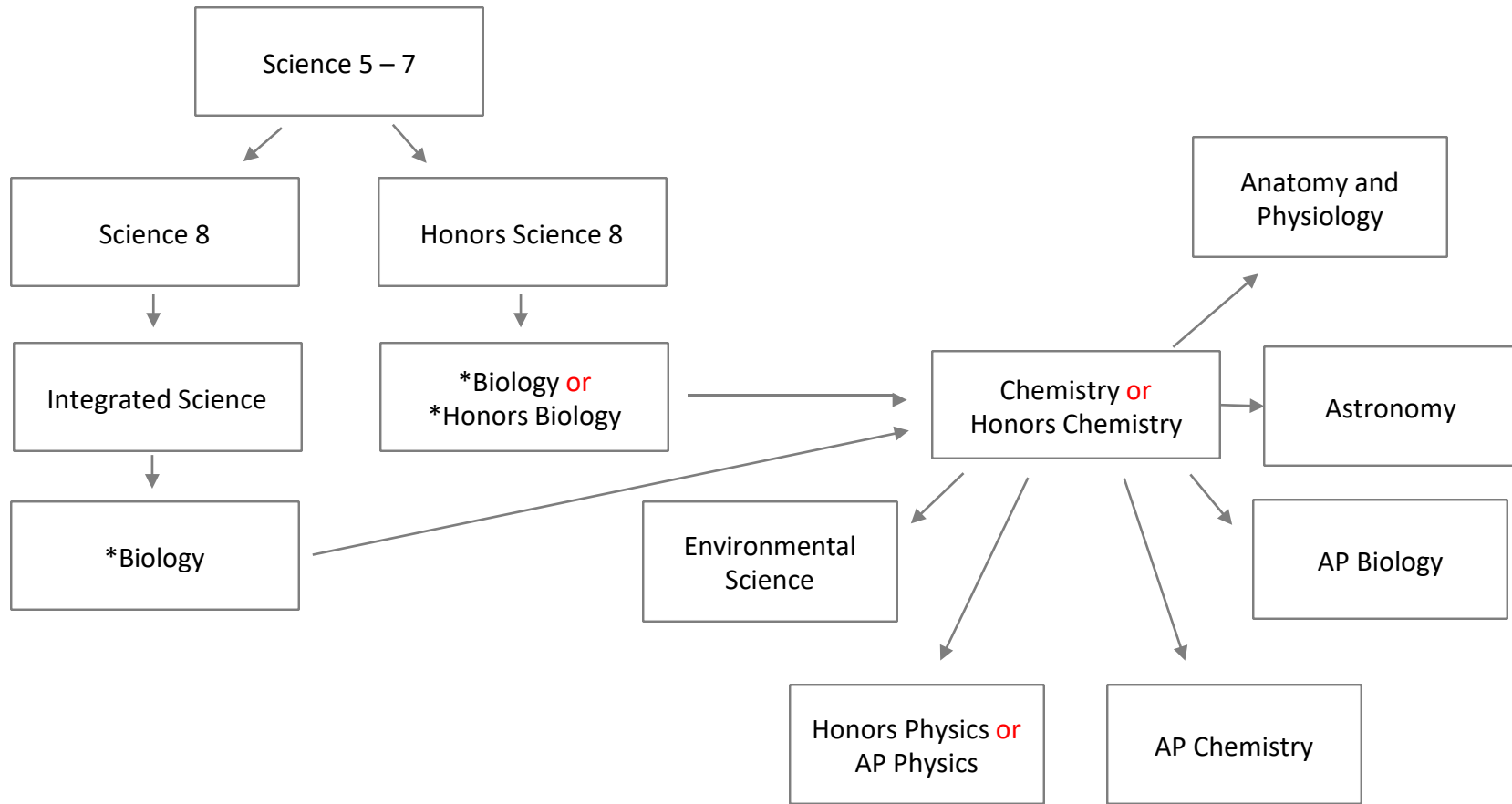
ENGLISH/LANGUAGE ARTS COURSE MAP

*English II is a state high school graduation requirement that includes a state end-of-course (EOC) exam. Four English credits are required for graduation. A student demonstrates competency by earning a score of 684 on the ELA II & ALG I end-of-course exams.



*Biology is a state science high school graduation requirement that includes a state end-of-course (EOC) exam. Four science credits are required for graduation. A student can earn the science seal by obtaining a proficient score of 3 on the Biology end-of-course exam.

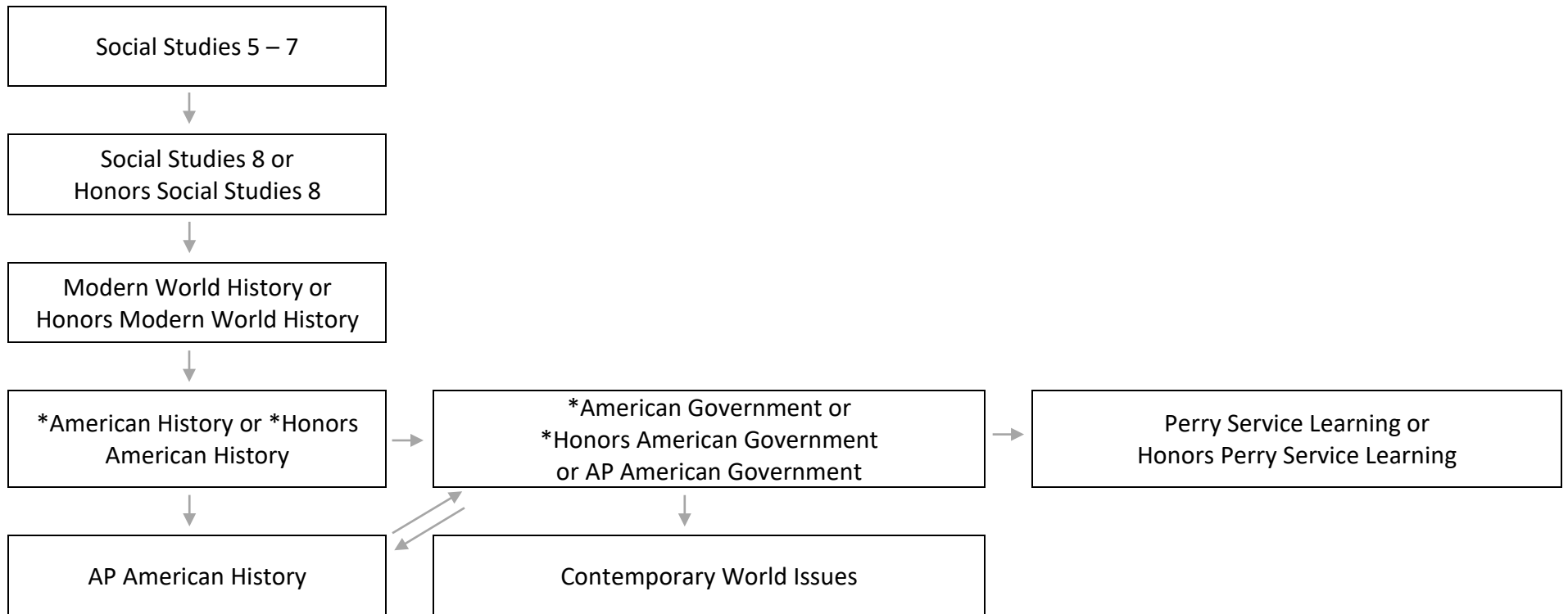

*This course is a state Social Studies graduation requirement that includes a state end-of-course (EOC) exam - The AP US History exam may be a substitute EOC exam for the American History course. The AP Government exam may be a substitute EOC exam for the American Government course. Four social studies credits are required for graduation.

A student can earn the citizenship seal by obtaining a proficient score of 3 on both the American Government and American History end-of-course exams.
