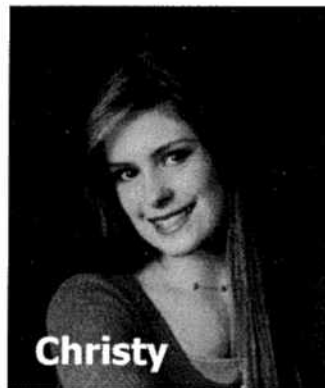
Two PHS Grads Win Alumni Association Scholarships

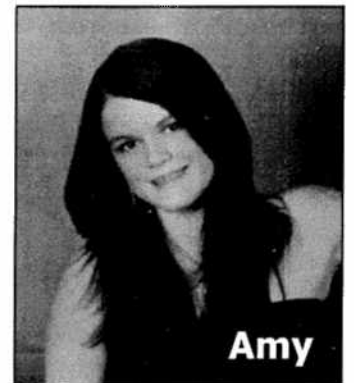

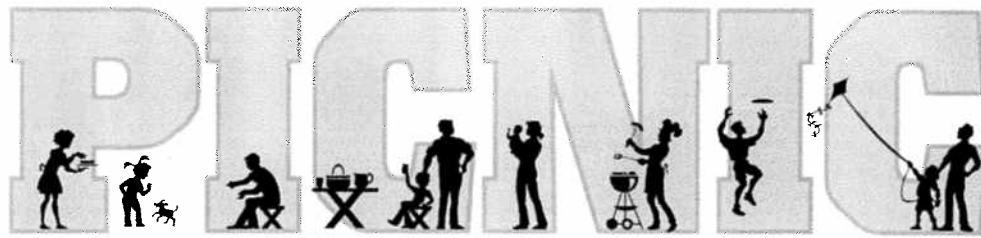

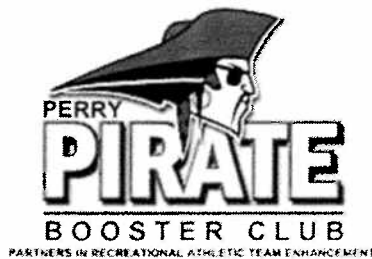

In July 2002, four PHS alumni blended their voices and musical talents to become "Circle of Friends," a Southern Gospel quartet.

The original quartet was comprised of Brad Ashburn '77, bass; Debbie Hobbins Ashburn '77, alto; Chip Barker '77, baritone; and Lisa Courtwright Pierce '86, soprano.

The group got its start when Brad, Debbie and Lisa performed together as part of the Mustard Seed Players, a Christian theater group that originated out of the Perry United Methodist Church. They enjoyed performing so much that they wanted to continue.

They all loved country and Christian music, which led them to Southern Gospel music. When it became clear to them that a trio consisting of a soprano, alto and bass would not work, they asked Chip to join them as tenor, which rounded out the four-part harmony.

In 2005, Chip moved on to devote more time to his church's ministry, which opened a position for the newest member of the Circle, Bobby Greener.

The Circle of Friends name has multiple meanings to the group. The members explain that they were all friends before they started the group, so they thought it

was appropriate to call themselves the Circle of Friends. A second meaning developed when they began performing. With each concert or church service that they performed, their circle of friends grew to include new friends in Christ.

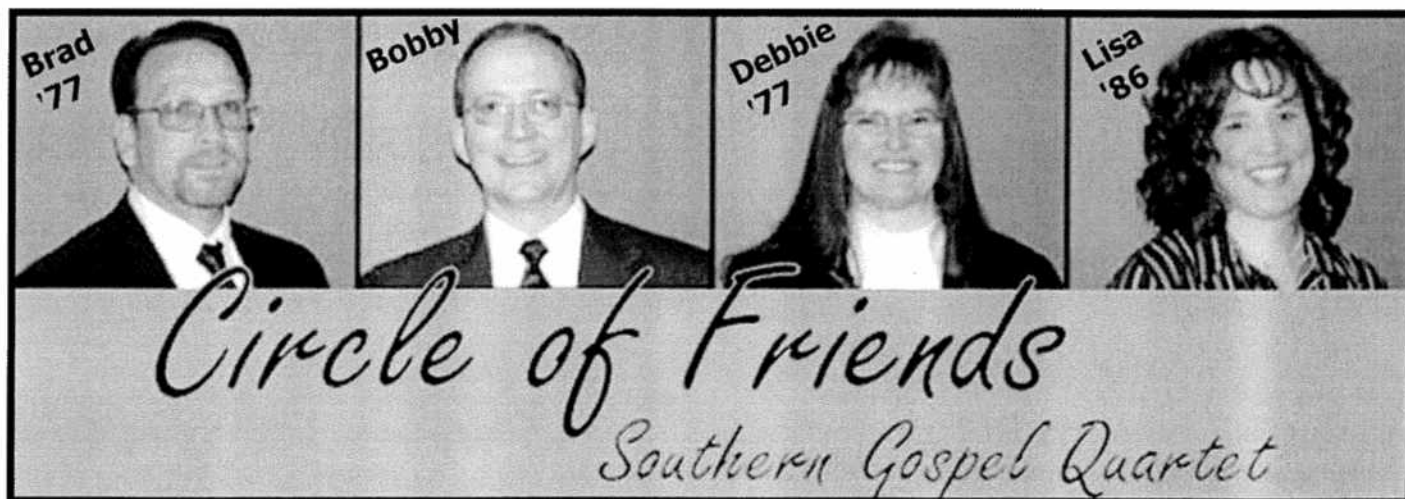
When asked about their most rewarding moment as a group, they responded, "The most rewarding moment for each of us is and has always been those times when someone comes to us after a concert and shares with us, 'You have no idea how much I needed this today.' To know that God has used us to bring hope and comfort to others through our music ministry is very humbling, yet rewarding."

Some highlights that the Circle of Friends offer as being very rewarding include:

- Winning the grand prize at the Hancock County Fair Talent Search
- The release of their first CD in December 2003
- Singing for over a thousand people at a gospel sing in Iowa
- The Gospel Trail (an all day gospel sing) which they host each August in Perry
- Opening for national recording artists Three Bridges
- Working with some amazing Nashville musicians

The Circle of Friends' accomplishments continue. They just returned from Nashville where they worked with a group of talented musicians who laid down the tracks for their new project. In preparing for the project, they received over 90 original songs

from various songwriters, and after much prayerful consideration, narrowed their selections to 12 songs that will be recorded. They're planning to return to Nashville in August to record the vocals and hope to release their new CD in September.

The group keeps busy performing 40 to 50 concerts and church services each year. They've traveled a good distance from northeast Ohio, as far south as Louisville, Kentucky; east to Clymer, New York; and west to Floyd, Iowa. They do this in addition to their full-time careers.

Brad and Debbie are co-owners of Breaktime Catering, a mobile catering business. Debbie is also the secretary at Perry

United Methodist Church. They live in Leroy.

Lisa is a piano teacher and co-owner of InterWright Technologies, a computer consulting firm. She makes her home in Perry.

Bobby is a technician with Leiken Motor Companies and resides in Mentor.

What keeps the group together and motivated to perform? "Aside from the rewarding moments we achieve together, we really are a 'circle of friends.' We love spending time together on and off the stage. We have always said that our primary purpose is to give glory to God through our songs, encourage people and win the lost to Christ—and have fun while doing it...and we do have fun!"

Before forming their own group, each musician

had many musical credits in his/her portfolio.

Lisa is an accomplished pianist who has played the piano since the age of five. She majored in music education at The University of Akron.

Debbie studied piano as a child and went on to play keyboard for the Madison Jazz Project. For many years she has been a member of the Perry Community Choir and continues to sing in the annual Easter Cantata.

Brad first began singing with the Perry Community Choir in the annual Easter Cantata. Later he was a vocalist for the Madison Jazz Project.

Bobby spent most of his school years playing the trumpet and singing in church choirs. He sang solo ministry in churches and was a member of the

Northeast Bible Institute College Choir.

This year's Gospel Trail—Singin' on the Grounds (founded and hosted by Circle of Friends), will be held on Saturday, August 25 from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Perry Community Center on Perry Park Road. 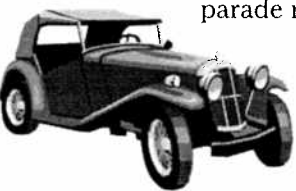
Groups from a number of states will be performing, but you'll also get a taste of some hometown favorites, including God's Country and The Matheny's.

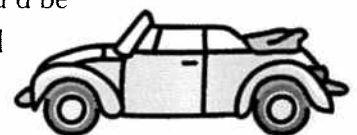

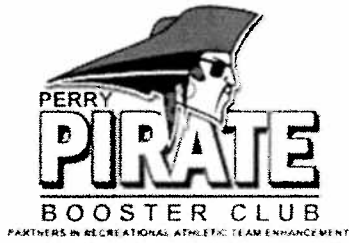

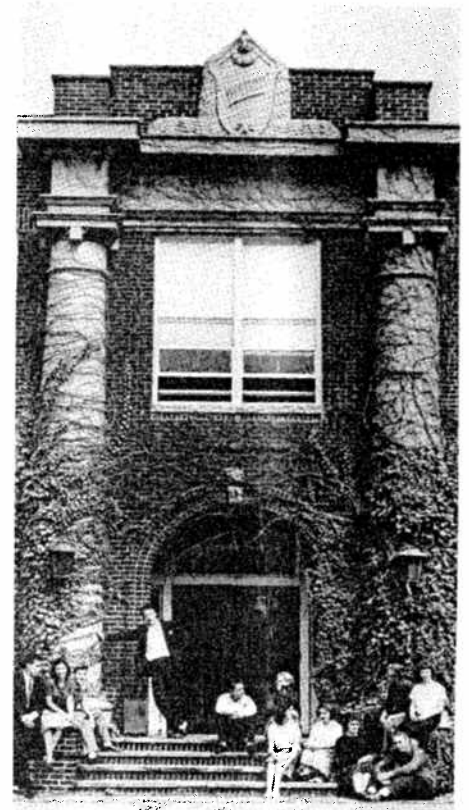
How long has it been since you walked the halls of Perry High School? Here's your chance to do it again!
