He was a founding stakeholder for the Regional Healthcare Pathways initiative that addressed the educational aspects of the area's healthcare providers. Just last year he earned the Ohio Department of Agriculture Outstanding Fair Supporter Award. Bob has been affiliated with the Lake County Fair for 33 years, including 24 years as the concession manager and 12 years as board president. He is a past district director of the Ohio Fair Manager's Association (OFMA) and was recently elected to his fourth consecutive two-year term as OFMA treasurer.


